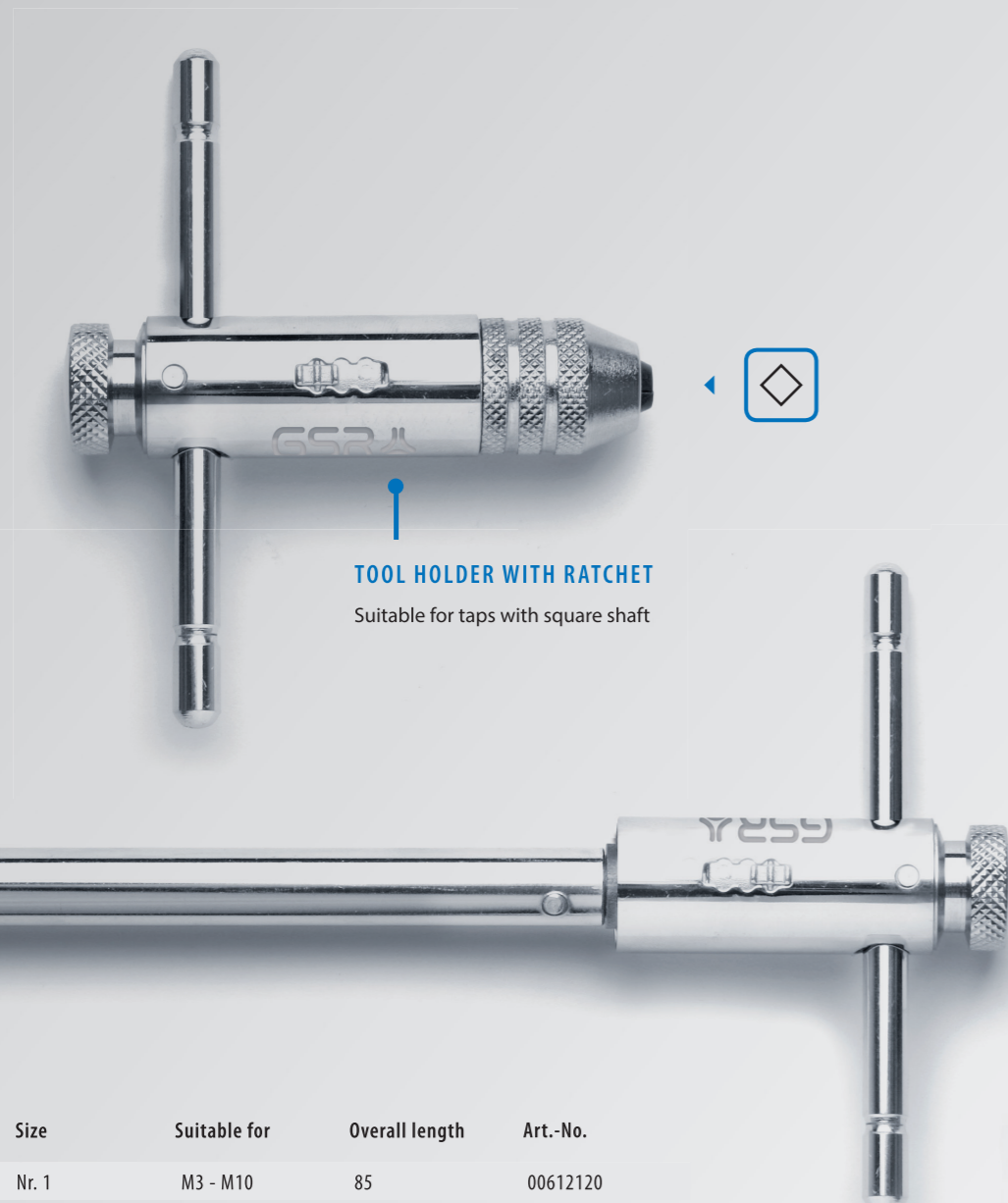


▶ TOOL HOLDER WITH RATCHET

General information about the toolholder with ratchet

As well as the standard tool holder, the new ratchet, is also equipped with a shift to reverse the working direction. The handle has three setting positions, also usable to work in difficult positions. The clamping chuck as well as the head of the tool holder has a knurled surface to get more grip. The true innovation is hidden in the head of the tool holder.

The recessed spirit level is the guide for vertically correct adjustment of the hand tap. The cutting result is more precise. This new tool holder is not only usable for hand taps. You can span all tools with square shank.



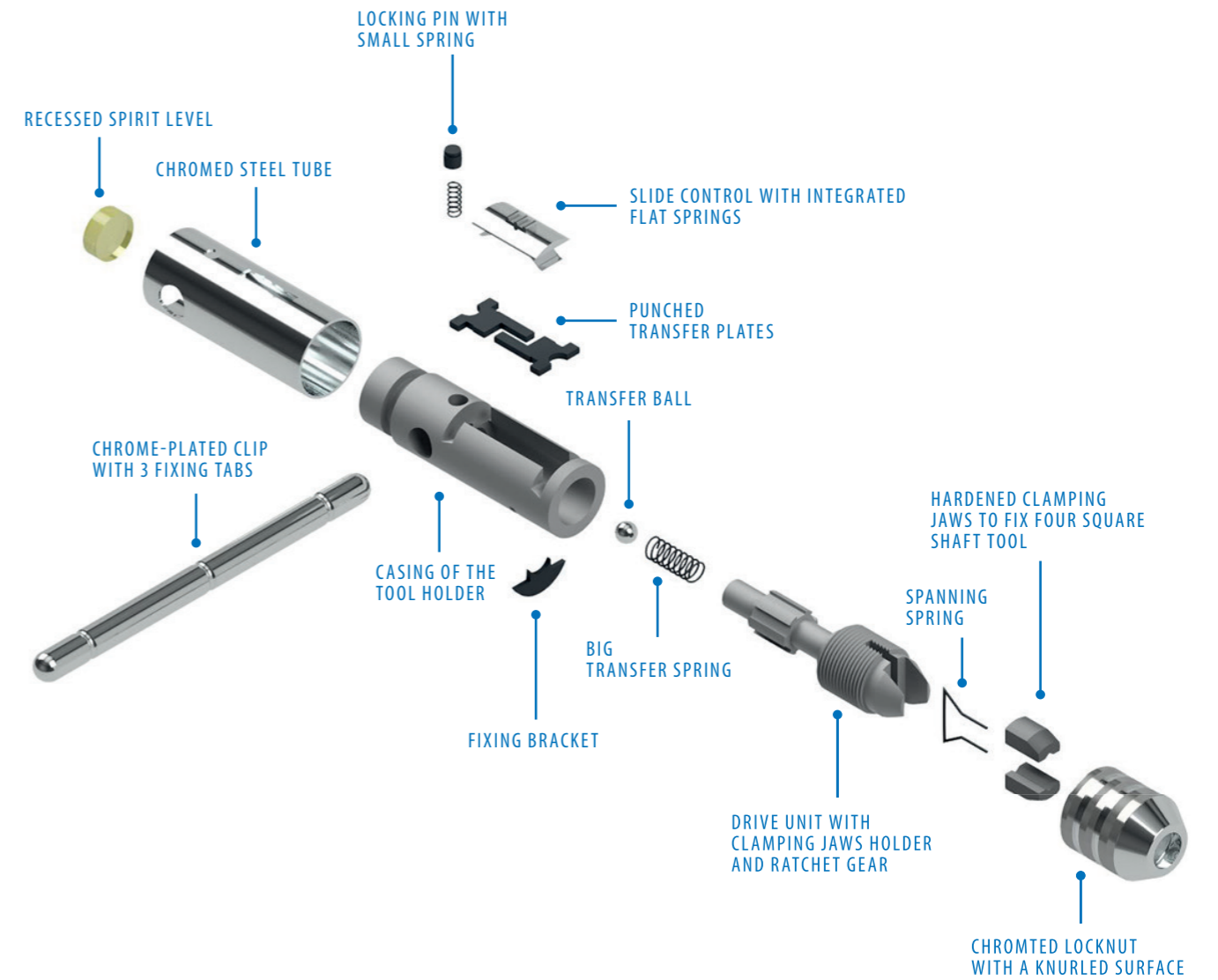

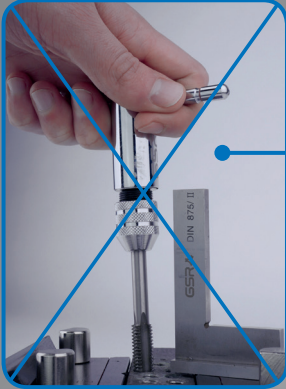
▶ EXPLODED VIEW

Tool holder with ratchet and centering lug

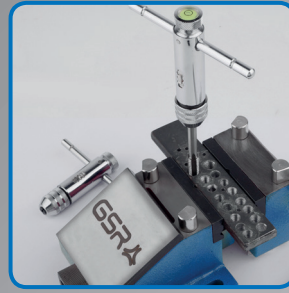

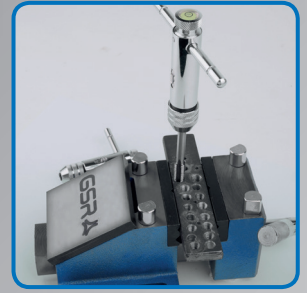

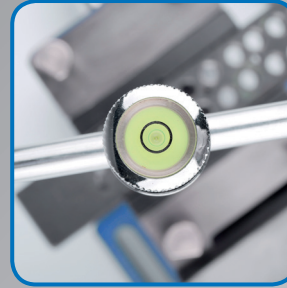

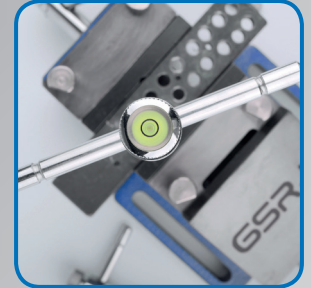
1. start smoothly to
